NEW ACQUISITION WILL EXPAND SACRED HEART SPECIALIZED RESIDENTIAL SERVICES AVAILABLE TO WOMEN.

MEMPHIS, MI - On December 1, 2007, Sacred Heart added New Life Home for Recovering Women to its growing continuum of services for addictive disorders and HIV/AIDS.

New Life Home operates a residential women's program on Detroit's east side. The primary funding source is the Detroit Bureau of Substance Abuse Prevention, Treatment and Recovery.

"We are thrilled to have New Life join the Sacred Heart family," said Grady L. Wilkinson, Chief Executive Officer of Sacred Heart. "Like Sacred Heart, New Life Home has a rich legacy of charitable community service, having served more than 1,200 women since opening in 1984. Sacred Heart is now the largest provider of specialized women's addictions treatment services in Michigan."

With 35 residential treatment beds, New Life Home is the largest facility of its kind in Detroit. New Life Home provides long-term residential treatment specializing in addressing the needs of women, particularly women with dependent children. In addition, New Life offers fifteen additional beds in two additional homes nearby for supportive housing for women who have completed that treatment.

Sacred Heart is a non-denominational, non-profit charitable service corporation. In addition to the New Life program, Sacred Heart offers prevention and outpatient treatment services in Detroit and six other locations in southeast Michigan. Sacred Heart also offers adult detoxification and residential addictions treatment at its main campus in Memphis; specialized residential addictions services for women and women with children at its Clearview program in Port Huron and HIV/AIDS outreach and case management services at its Bay City office.
